- Organizations or individuals who are interested in activities and projects that promote valley fever awareness are eligible to apply.
- College students who are interested in conducting Valley Fever related research or projects are eligible to apply.

To receive the grant, the applicant must

- Complete the Valley Fever Awareness Grant application,
- Provide a brief description of the proposed activity or project.
- Explain how the activity or project will increase Valley Fever awareness in the community.
- Conduct the proposed activity or project to increase community Valley Fever awareness.
- Applicants may request up to \$1000 in funding. The amount awarded varies based on the complexity of the project. The board may require additional information, ie: budget proposal.

Recipients of the award are required to submit a presentation, such as PowerPoint, infographics, or flyers, on the outcomes of the funded project to the VFAF board.

Acceptance of the grant implies consent to post the report on the VFAF website.
